Shake Your Head in Wonder About Bills Too?

I'm not talking about bills in your mail that you need to pay. I'm talking about proposals that our legislature introduces and then votes on to make a law. The most recent one stops PFAs from being added to feminine care products. PFAs are bad - don't get me wrong. But to think that "evil manufacturers" add PFAs to feminine hygiene products is absurd.

Manufacturers want to make a buck, true. But they don't add bad chemicals to their products, it is the manufacturing process and what they use that contain toxins dangerous for our skin to be near (cotton grown with pesticides, chemicals sprayed on the machinery so it runs, plastics in packaging etc.) NOT the addition of PFAs - the bill that protects us from such additions does NOTHING.

Or just require less than 1g be added. The frying process - when seed oils are reheated and reused over and over creates more trans fats than they could ever "add"!

Do politicians know any of this? What are they doing signing a bill they know nothing about?! Is that why the phrase, "we pass it, then we can read it?!"

"Their mentality goes, it's their life and their store, and there is no need to live life bounded by the 'anchos' (stress)[of] obeying and serving others"

These people expect to control when they want to work; they want to control when they play. Their traditional festivals may last for days! Friendly and very community oriented, they are open and hospitable, making even strangers feel, "welcome, cared for and part of the Ikarian way of life."

They don't rely on tourism for their lifestyle. .

They were "self-sufficient people, mainly shepherds, farmers, fishermen, shop owners and craftsmen. They farm their own land - with most households growing their own supply of organic fruit, vegetables and herbs."

They work hard beginning in their teens. In spite of being a gorgeous place with rugged, lush land, huge rocks and waterfalls, stunningly colorful, dramatic sunsets with brilliant sea sky and light combinations, its pretty much off the tourism map (unlike the surrounding, more modern islands that are rich

with commercialism.)

This is so different that in Ikaria, about seven years ago, they realized that they weren't using their police station and decided as a community that "they didn't want or need policing - they do it perfectly well themselves."

Yet the island remains one of the safest places to live with crime virtually nonexistant.

Dr. Price in his book Nutrition and Physical Degeneration said this was an outgrowth of living on food as nature intended - rather than processed by man. He found the primitive peoples that he studied, as long as they lived without processed foods, had strong teeth and bodies and little to no crime in their communities.




