Electricity Shut Off Locally (SCE & Residents)

This article will take a look at why SCE says it is, "turning off electricity during times of high wind" and we will look at what the resident's logic is.

SCE turned off the electricity in Spring Mountain Ranch to *some* residents and didn't turn it back on for four to eight days - the first time. And again the following week. Any time there was high wind - or a threat of wind, to be accurate. At one of the threat of wind moments I took a picture and it was 4mph - not exactly windy. Were the Devastating CA Fires from Negligence?

Maybe by looking into the cause of the fires and the experiences of those whose homes were saved, a repeat may be prevented.

I heard a Manhattan Beach resident share their experience of the tragedy and they said, "mother nature is crazy and there is nothing we can do to prevent fires and firestorms when they build in areas where they shouldn't build - so close to the woodland areas."

"The deadliest fire in California history - the 2018 Camp Fire that burned down Paradise in Nov 2018 and killed 85 people - was allegedly caused by an old power line and equipment that dates back to 1921, 100 year old equipment." Tierney Real News Network, Substack or TRNNS)

Focus on Green Energy instead of Repairing Grid

California's power grid is ancient. Most of its towers were built before 1950. "The electric company knows its old power lines are a problem but they were MANDATED [under Brown and Newsom's watch] to focus on green energy. Rather than repair the outdated, existing infrastucture by spending \$1.4 Billion on upgrades as PG&E did in 2017; 2018's mandates saw PG&E put \$2.4 Billion into green energy instead."

Controlled Burns and Logging Not Allowed

Dense brush and forests grow. In the past, underbrush was eliminated with controlled burns but such controlled burns of underbrush are no longer permitted. Logging operations used to clear lumber. But clearing dead lumber, "was depicted as an act of cruelty..."

Developing Closer to Wilderness Areas

"...developers building closer to wilderness areas are the start of a recipe for disaster...all that would be needed is a spark."

Samaritan's Purse Helping Wildfire Homeowners

I had no idea the blessing Samaritan's Purse Ministries are to victims of disasters. Dear friends of ours have served helping the victims of Hurricane Katrina and the disaster in Houston through Samaritan's Purse.

Most organizations have huge administrative overhead - not Samaritan's Purse! 95% of donations go directly to the cause, but compounding benefits, volunteers serve several purposes. *One is to help families who lost everything but their lives, sift through the rubble*. One is to help the community recoup government funds. *When FEMA goes into an area, it is not free and the community has to pay that back.* Samaritan's Purse is often the first organization to help in a disaster (often even before FEMA can move on it.) Volunteer hours add up toward recovering some of the debt the community loses through the clean-up process.

Samaritan's Purse benefits the local economy by buying rebuilding supplies locally. They also bring the message of Hope that Jesus provides for the forgiveness of sins.

President Franklin Graham encouraged California residents on Monday, Jan. 27, in the wake of wildfires that have claimed dozens of lives and destroyed nearly ten thousand structures in LA County.

He offered words of encouragement to homeowners in Eaton Canyon communities where our teams are hard at work assisting residents to recover valuables and keepsakes not claimed in the blaze. He heard harrowing stories as residents recounted their experience with the deadly fires, which began on Jan. 7 and scorched tens of thousands of populated acres, driven by strong Santa Ana winds.

Graham met with a homeowner named Evelyn who said she evacuated at 2 a.m. and tried to find many of the valuable items that belonged to her mother. One keepsake in particular is still missing—a special figurine that her mother brought to the states when immigrating from Cuba in 1960s.

She hopes our team can find it.

"We have our lives. We did get a few important things out," Evelyn told Graham. "I was in denial that morning. The fire moved very, very quickly. It moved in this area and out the next day. We never would've imagined that this would happen. Thank you all for coming and for helping us."

Kitty McCormick was so grateful for help in finding cherished jewelry and wedding keepsakes.

Franklin Graham takes time to pray with a homeowner. "It's incredible what you're doing here for us," she said. "This is a strong community. This is our forever home. I've been here almost 10 years. We always thought we were coming back like a lot of people did." Peaceful Valley Donkey Rescue and San Bernardino County Department of Public Health have mutually agreed to conclude the contract for wild burro rescue and relocation services.



Riv Nurseries Can't Sell Citrus, HomeDepot Can? How is it right that small businesses in and near Riverside City cannot sell citrus trees, but Home Depot can? Please make it make sense!

Riverside City Nurseries are not allowed to sell citrus right now - again because of Huanglongbing (HLB) aka "Citrus Greening Disease."

It is said to be caused by a bacterium called candidatus Liberibacter, spread by the Asian citrus psyllid (Diaphorina citri). The CDFA has strict regulations such that even though all nurseries and Home Depot are required to comply, some of *the regulations are too onerous or particular for smaller businesses to afford*.

Pest-exclusionary greenhouses, movement permits; secure packaging and traceability are supposedly management protocols too costly for the local nurseries. AI said that regular inspections, fines or penalties for violations and mandatory public education campaigns are also part of the requirements.

I spoke with the owner of Parkview Nursery and he basically said it was too many hoops. It is interesting to me as I have seen a citrus tree get the symptoms of the "citrus greening." Yet a new tree in the same location grows an amazing amount of citrus every year. But it requires an application of compost at least every two years to produce healthy fruit. Yes, the experiment is only on one tree - not a large sample size! Yet the results coincide with the research AI also provided on how the application of compost could help:

"1. Enhanced Soil Microbial Diversity

Compost increases beneficial microbial populations, which can suppress pathogens like Candidatus Liberibacter. Beneficial microbes in compost may also improve root health, reducing stress on the tree.

2. Improved Plant Nutrition

Nutrient-rich compost provides essential elements

like nitrogen, phosphorus, and potassium, which strengthen the tree's overall health and growth. Healthier plants can tolerate the effects of HLB more effectively.

3. Induction of Systemic Resistance

Compost may stimulate the plant's immune system, helping it resist further infection. Some studies have explored how compost enhances the production of plant hormones associated with disease resistance.

4. Reduction of Secondary Stress Factors

Compost improves soil structure, water retention, and root growth, reducing secondary stresses like drought or nutrients deficiency that exacerbate the impact of HLB."

Just like in the human gut, proper nutrition in the form of compost, can make a difference in a tree's resistance to disease.

Does it seem right that none of the CDFA's mitigation requirements address the health of the soil?

Devastating Fires Negligence?(Cont. from P.4) tragic devastation and had the military get the water back on from up North.

But didn't California residents vote on a bond initiative to put in reservoirs for such an event? Yes, the California Globe reported in 2022:

"In November 2014, California voters approved Proposition 1: The Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act. The \$7.5 billion bond dedicated \$2.7 billion for the public benefits of new water storage projects. Some ask, 'Why have no new reservoirs been built in the seven years since?' Rest assured, there are projects in the works. All recently passed a key milestone and are moving forward."

Would a reservoir have made a difference? Maybe. A home with misters and a gentle stream of water is still standing amidst the destruction of all the homes

surrounding it. Water can be critical.

Firefighting Equipment refused or Left Idle

Besides the \$18 million budget cut from the Los Angeles Mayor Karen Bass that might have contributed,

"One journalist went to the Los Angeles Fire Department repair yard and found (on video) hundreds of firetrucks that could have been used to fight the fires. 20% of the LAFD's fleet was out of service - either in disrapair, sent to Ukraine, or just sitting idle." (Tierney's Real News on Substack)

Canada supposedly offered and sent sixty Fire-Trucks - declined by Newsom for "not passing smog"?

Fire insurance was cancelled four months ago said one resident, Mel Gibson (assigned to Trump's task force for LA) A blue VW van survived the fire intact.


for offenses against the United States after an individual has been legally charged and convicted before a pardon can be granted.




