#### The Great American Eclipse of 2024

While the eclipse last month may not have been a big deal for many, it was spectacular for those in the path of totality. I was one of the 31 million Americans living in the path of totality for the solar eclipse on April 8, 2024. Another 4 million traveled from all over the country to witness the complete solar eclipse. Having never experienced a total eclipse before, I had no idea what to expect, but it ended up being an experience which I will remember for the rest of my life.

The day of the eclipse was clear, warm, and sunny. A little after noon, my husband and I headed to our backyard with a lawn chair, picnic blanket, and our eclipse glasses to watch the skies.

Once the sun was about 90% covered, the lighting became noticeably different. The light around us was dim, but unlike at dawn or dusk. It was eerie, like the light before a storm. It was almost like a spotlight was illuminating our entire town, a spotlight which progressively became dimmer over time.

At 2:04pm, the eclipse reached totality. For a few minutes, we had complete darkness in the middle of the day. When we looked up at the sun, we could see a bright ring surrounding the dark moon. Our streetlights turned on. The birds continued chirping, sounding very confused. And then, very slowly, the light came back.

The next solar eclipse will not be visible from the United States until August 23, 2044. Only three states will be in the path of totality: Montana, North Dakota, and South Dakota. You can also mark your calendars for August 12, 2045, when a total solar eclipse will be visible from California.

My current home in southeastern Illinois will not experience another total solar eclipse for 374 years, so I feel immensely blessed that I was able to witness such a wonder it in my lifetime. I hope that, when the next total solar eclipse comes back to the States, you are able to do the same.




