Did the Cannabis Money Go Up in Smoke?

California has collected over \$6.7 Billion in cannabis tax revenue since legal sales began in 2018. Under Prop 64 this money is allocated by the state into the following general buckets:


Youth Programs 60% - (to teach youths to stay away from cannabis, no more than 20%); child-care vouchers for low income families

Public Safety 20% - Local Police and Fire; Addressing health and safety needs caused by cannabis legalization.

Environmental 20% - Combating illegal grows, wildland restoration and investments in local parks.

Why, then, does the local community seem to not see the benefits of this money?. Especially since the state of California receives 15% of gross receipts plus 7.75% sales tax on everything sold there.

Maybe we need to ask, "Where is our cannabis tax money going - and if we have to have it - how can we make sure it helps our neighborhood?


Watching the Money Markets?

If you had purchased bitcoin when the Highgrove Happenings covered the pros and cons about it, you would have made a pretty penny! I just cashed out \$3000 on a three hundred dollar investment while leaving the original \$300 in bitcoin (and it has gone up again!)

But something I have noticed is really interesting and I wonder if you could help me understand it.

It seems every time we check goldprice.org and the price of gold and silver is down (like today, 5/22/2025), bitcoin is up... and the converse is also true. Gold and silver up? Bitcoin is down.

The US dollar seems out of the running as a future currency because banks and foreign interests are investing in gold, and using XRP for their accounting infrastructure.

Want A Long, Healthy Life? Pt.3

The "Blue Zones" are where their people are said to live ten years longer (on average) than the rest of us. (First we looked at Ikaria, Greece in April; then Japan's lack of obesity in May attributed to the focus on eating whole, real food and traditional living.)

This month we bring you research from Sardinia, Italy where a larger number of people - especially men - live to and beyond 100 in the mountainous, rural interior. This is unusual as most longevity areas show women outliving men by a large margin.

Movement is a part of life here and most of the longest lived people are either male shepherds or women gardeners. They eat no processed foods, unless you call fermenting and traditionally handled foods a form of "processing".

TRADITIONAL SARDINIAN LONGEVITY DIET

(SAMPLE WEEK)

Long Life pt 3 (Cont. from Front P) is Simple with fewer ingredients and minimal processing. The people eat what they grow - it is local and only what grows in the season. It is low glycemic and high fiber. They do occasionally eat organ meats - usually at festivals and they eat nose to tail. They include "longevity favoring" fats such as from sheep's milk and fresh, raw olive oil, but most importantly, they eat with family, slowly, savoring the time together.

Daily staples in the Sardinian diet include pane carasau or flatbread; pecorino cheese from sheep's milk; olive oil, cannonau wine 1-2 small glasses per day with the main meal as well as fresh, bitter herbs such as dandelion, rosemary, thyme and wild fennel.

Growing food, caring for animals, living close to nature gives people not only a reason to wake up but a tangible, grounding rhythm to life.




