Mt. Vernon Avenue and Center Street



Highgrove before the Spring Mountain Ranch Homes were built. The 1450 homes added to Highgrove that now cover most of the vacant land in this picture (SMR) were delayed for many years when the economy slowed in 2006. But water flows downhill and the builders made sure it flowed properly. The sewer was extended under Center Street from near Iowa Avenue, to provide for the new homes and the zoning changed from 20,000 square foot lots to the minimum of 7,200 SF lots currently in Spring Mountain Ranch. From 2012-2025, Steven Burzansky owned the area northeast of Center St and Mt. Vernon Avenue (yellow highlighted box), right before he sold it, he arranged through the Supervisor's office and public hearings for the lot sizes to again be lowered. Locals requested single-family homes, wider streets, longer driveways, and more visual protection (no bedrooms overlooking current residences on Carlin Ln.) to keep

their privacy from the new, gated community. The new owners, KB Homes (as of Oct. 31, 2024), have broken ground. See Oct '24.HGH for plan as approved: <u>HighgroveHappeningsNewspaper.com</u>

HHS Hearing on A Sick Medical System

The recent Congressional Hearing had many eyeopening - even shocking admissions!

The big message of the hearing? Our system is really broken. "The United States remains the SICK-EST developed nation," said HHS Secretary Robert F. Kennedy Jr. as he opened his testimony before congress. "And yet we spend \$4.5 trillion annually on healthcare, 2 to 3 times more per capita than comparable nations."

The system was shown to be not only wasteful, but possibly unsustainable. Healthcare costs are rising faster than the economy, with poorer health outcomes.

1) Tackle mental health and addiction head-on: "These issues now rival chronic diseases in their im-

pact... HHS will aggressively combat the opiod crisis, especially the spread of synthetic drugs like fentanyl.

- **2)Prioritize nutrition and healthy lifestyles**: "The presidents's budget requests \$94 billion in discretionary funds to support these priorities, including the Administration for a Healthy America."
- 3) Clean up the U.S. food system: "We will equip FDA to remove harmful chemicals from food and packaging and close the GRAS (Generally Regarded as Safe) loophole.

The investigation continued into vaccines and started with firing all of the ACIP members who not only hadn't investigated any adverse reactions in seven years, and through whom there were money ties to pharmaceutical companies.

The new vaccine advisory panel has researchers and physicians who have vowed to use "evidence-based medicine" to study the cumulative effect of the childhood vaccine schedule and make vaccine recommendations. Some believe this is important as *today's children get 70 doses of 15 different vaccines - many*

more than we got as children - and there is no upper limit to how many a child may receive at one time (is there evidence this is safe?)

Have you heard any stories of moms claiming their child was normal until shortly after a shot? It may be coincidence, but probably wise to look into. No one wants their child harmed. In the 1990's, autism affected one in every 130 children. Now it is 1 in 30.

"Caring about vaccine safety doesn't make one anti-vaccine", Kulldorff said, "In fact, to thoroughly scrutinize and ensure the safety and efficacy of vaccines is a pro-vaccine position, just like the promotion of aviation safety is a pro-airline position."

The American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) denounced the new committee in an X post saying they will continue to issue their own recommendations.


Step 1: Verify Citizenship for All Registrations:

Only U.S. citizens should determine California's future. Our law will mandate proof of citizenship when registering to vote, closing loopholes and protecting voter rolls from error or abuse.

Step 2: Require Voter ID for Every Ballot Counted:

All votes, whether cast in-person or by mail, will be counted only after verification of a government-issued identification—a trusted practice in many states and in daily activities.




